Sub: Project Closure / Completion of works for HIPC 75 MW DG Set Based Power Plant

Dear Sirs,

At the outset, we congratulate our complete team to have closed the Project on a successful note with Plant performance at its optimum. Trust for sure, this Plant will set an example of a Model Plant in Yemen. The meeting recently concluded with Wartsila Finland Team on 9th March 2011 at HIPC Site, Mukalla is self explanatory in this regard. Although, we had liked to submit the report immediately after conclusion of the meeting, a little delay on our part owing to our busy schedule for visit to China to attend the Technical discussions/ Inspection Works for the ordered items for the Steel Plant substation.

As you are aware the O & M is being carried out by Wartsila O & M team from 01.07.2010 onwards and the plant is under regular commercial production since then. The Plant is taken over formally on 12th August 2010, however, Operation Date has been considered from 01.07.2010 as per the Contract for the 1st Phase of Operation.

There are no site activities remaining to be attended to, and hence there is no reporting of progress after the last Progress Report No. 12 for the period upto 31.10.2010, by which time virtually all the works have been completed. Further, all the 10 Nos. DG sets have been taken on commercial production and as such HIPC have been sending power to PEC grid at Al Harshiyat.

The Warranty has been announced and will be contractually complied to. Warranty with respect to the Engines shall begin from the date of Performance Test and Reliability Run completion certificate and ends after 18 months. Warranty with respect to the Equipment, excluding engines begins from the date of Performance Test and Reliability Run completion certificate and ends after 12 months. Enclosed for reference is the Warranty Claim Status as on March 2011.

The complete Payment under the Supply Contract has been effected (Financial Closure) and is reflected in the last page of the Meeting notes concluded at Mukalla on 9th March 2011.

All the reports pertaining to the Project viz. the Final Handing Over certificates including the Performance Test & Reliability Test Run Certificates of all the Engines, Complete Report – HIPC Project from Inception including photos, Closure meeting dated 9th March at Mukalla, Handover of the Plant Operations to Wartsila O & M team with punch list items, the last Progress Report etc. are enclosed herewith for your reference in a nut shell.

Also enclosed is the information for the Annual operating plan which includes the provisional planning as regards to the Engine Wise Running hours & the routine maintenance at each scheduled intervention falling during such period.
